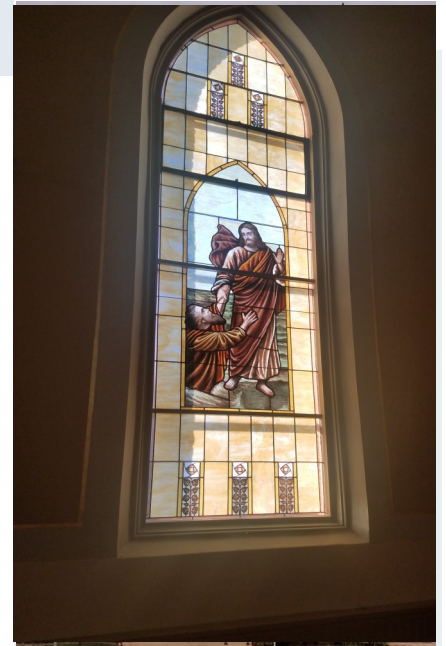
May God bless us as we live a God-lived life, serving others!

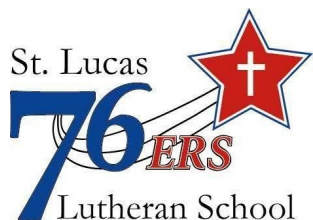
