FORWARD: IT'S REALLY HAPPENING

The congregational meeting on Sunday, October 20, was the most historic meeting at our church since 1913. The voters approved moving ahead with construction for a new church building. On Tuesday, October 22, the Kewaskum Plan Commission gave their approval to the building plans. After nearly 15 years of praying, planning, and generous offerings from God's people, we are now ready to break ground for a new building in which we will worship the Lord and grow together as a church family.

Groundbreaking for the new church will be celebrated on Sunday, December 8. On that day we will have one church service at 9:30 am. Following the service in church, we will move to the new church site for the Rite of Groundbreaking. At the conclusion of the service, we will hold a celebration meal in the school gymnasium. Watch for more information in the church bulletin, the church website, and the December Prescription Notes. Sunday School and Bible Hour will be begin at 8:15 am that Sunday. Saturday worship will be held at the usual time of 6:00 pm.

Some aspects of the plan will need to be delayed until funding is available. Attached to this edition of Prescription Notes is an explanation of funds available, total building cost, items eliminated from the plan, and projects deferred until funding is available.

Volunteer forms are available in the back of church and in the school office. There will be many opportunities for skilled and unskilled workers to contribute to this project. The form also includes a section for companies which would like to bid on the project. If you or your employer is interested, the information will be passed on to Catalyst Construction.

The architects from Groth Design Group will complete the construction documents on November 1 and submit them to the state for approval. An early approval will allow us to conduct the bidding process starting the first full week in November. One of our members who owns a tree removal service will clear the lot of trees in the next few weeks. The goal is the start excavating and pouring the foundations in mid-December. The Task Force will be meeting twice in November to work on bids and construction schedule.

Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good! Thanks be to God for blessing the project to this point. Pray that he will continue to bless us as we move ahead with this exciting project. Pray that he continues to bless our congregation in every way.
