INTRODUCING THE ST. LUCAS LUTHERAN LADIES GUILD

The purpose of the Ladies Guild is to further the kingdom of God, to assist the youth, to support missions, to contribute to charity, and to serve the congregation.

At each monthly meeting the Guild collects mission money, all of which is distributed to various ministries.

The Ladies Guild supports: *Lutheran Women’s Missionary Society* — Dues are paid so that all women of our congregation are members of Lutheran Women’s Mission Society. All women and even their husbands can attend rallies in Dodge/Washington counties. These rallies are held at various congregations in spring and fall. St. Lucas will be hosting again in the fall of 2023. *Cradle Roll* — When babies are baptized they start to receive materials for each stage of their growth, including a baptismal book on what baptism is, a mailing every 6 months with tips and truths for the parents, a CD with music, and books for the child, continuing until the child is 4 years old. *Pastor Hoenecke Memorial Book Fund* — The Guild founded and manages the Hoeneke book fund which purchases Bibles for children of St. Lucas entering 3rd grade and Catechisms for those entering 5th grade. *Serving Meals* — The Guild serves a lunch to St. Lucas school at least once during a school year, chili at one of the soup suppers during Lent, and desserts and treats for National Night Out. *Kettle Moraine Lutheran High School* — Treats for the faculty and staff one month per year.

Fun things the Guild does: Monthly meetings are held the third Thursday of each month at 6:30 PM in the church basement, including a devotion by the pastor, a short business meeting, and refreshments along with fellowship; a summer picnic; Random Lake community play with a spaghetti dinne; a Christmas party every December.
